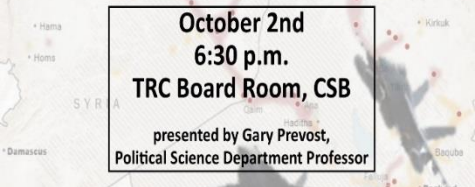

The Islamic State (IS), also known as the Islamic State in Iraq and Syria (ISIS) has emerged in 2014 as a major factor in the political life of the Middle East. It is a holy war organization that claims religious authority over all Muslims in the world and aims to bring the Muslim-inhabited regions of the world under its control beginning with Iraq and Syria. It has been declared a terrorist organization by the United States government and military actions, including airstrikes, have been carried out against it in both Iraq and Syria. Within the last month hundreds of U.S. soldiers have been sent to Iraq to assist that government in its war with ISIS. This presentation will review the history of IS, including its political philosophy and explore the ramifications of renewed U.S. military actions in the region. Gary Prevost is Professor of Political Science at CSB/SJU and regularly teaches Middle East Politics. He is also an expert on revolutionary movements.
