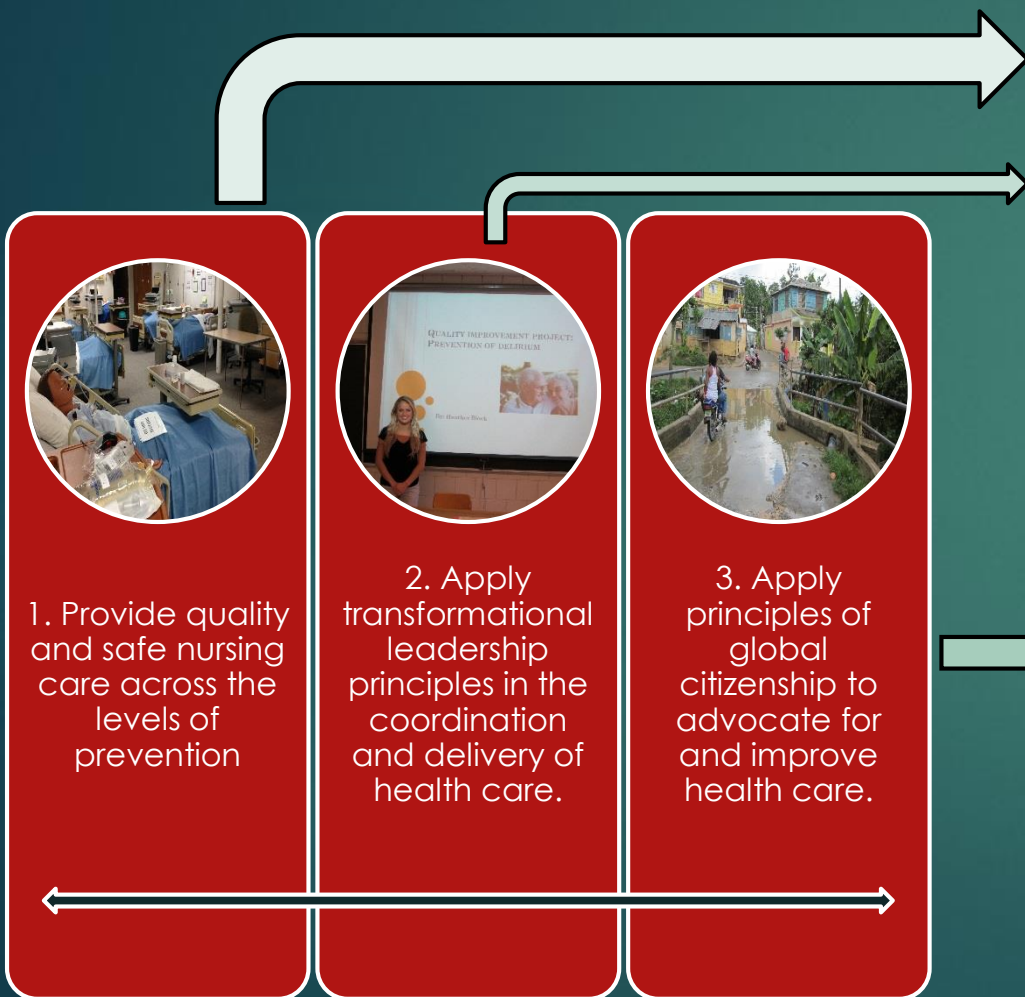


# Assessment and Evaluation in Nursing

Are nursing students achieving the learning outcomes for the major?



Example Methods of Evaluation	Expected Performance Level	Responsibility for completing	Time Frame	Actual Results
Clinical performance	Clinical assessment rubric: mean 3.5 or higher on a 1-4 Likert scale.	NRSG 395 (capstone) course faculty	Annually in Spring; report to faculty in Fall	TBA; data collection begins spring 2015
Educational Benchmark, Inc. alumni survey and employer satisfaction	Mean of 5.0 or higher on EBI on items related to transformational leadership	Assessment and evaluation committee	Annually in Summer; aggregate data and report every three years.	TBA; data collection begins summer 2015
Student exit survey at graduation	Mean of 3.5 or higher on questions related to global citizenship	Assessment and evaluation committee	Annually in Spring; report to faculty in Fall	TBA; data collection begins spring 2015
